



APL UNLEASHED 2026 Poker Run Participant Safety Agreement

Animal Protection League, your host for this event, wants to ensure that all participants remain safe and have a fun day on the water. The stops for the event are not timed and will remain open long enough for all boats to complete the routes. Please maintain safe speeds for passengers, other participants, and non-participants so that all may enjoy our beautiful California Delta.

- All drivers must acknowledge and sign this Driver Safety Agreement- The Driver is responsible for enforcing all rules for this Poker Run on their vessel.
- All Participants must acknowledge and sign the Poker Run Liability Waiver
- Participating Boats and Drivers will only carry participating passengers. This is indicated by armbands and signed waivers for all.
- All Boats must obey posted and unposted State and County boat regulations, including but not limited to speed limits, no wake zones, and right-of-way laws.
- All Passengers in any boat capable of traveling more than 40mph must wear approved life vests.
- Drivers must abstain from alcohol use during official Poker Run hours.
- This route may include bridges; the driver must ensure clearance or call ahead to have bridges opened.
- If your boat is equipped with additional safety equipment (lanyards, extinguishers, etc.), they must be operational and in use.
- All Boats Must be Insured; a Declaration Page for this policy will be required before the start of the event.
- It is the Drivers responsibility to maintain safe speeds and distance from fellow boaters, shores, and obstacles. Event organizers reserve the right to “eject” a driver, their boat, and passengers from the event if they are witnessed acting in any manner deemed unsafe.
- The Organizer reserves the right to refuse entry to the event to any boat or participant.
- The organizer requires all entrants to stay on the designated routes- failure to do so may result in removal from the event.
- Side tie parking is expected from All Participants.
- The Start of this event is not at a specific time, nor is the finish. Passing on the CA Delta can be hazardous and is not recommended in narrow areas.
